Drug Addiction in the Workplace

According to the National Institute on Drug Abuse, nearly 75 percent of adults who abuse drugs/ alcohol are employed full-time. Chances are good that you will have to deal with an employee's substance use disorder.

Lost Productivity

According to the U.S. Department of Labor, employees who abuse substances are 25-30 percent less productive and miss work three times more often than non-abusing employees.
