### 1.0 PURPOSE:

To define the guidelines for personal dress in the workplace.

- **3.0 GUIDELINES**: All employees are expected to dress appropriately for their environment.
  - 3.1 Cummins Inc. is a business casual work environment; however, all casual clothing is not suitable for the workplace.
  - 3.2 Clothing that reveals too much cleavage, your back, underarm, your chest, your stomach or your underwear is not appropriate for a place of business, even in a business casual setting. Skirt and shorts (refer to site specific policy if available) length should be appropriate for business setting.
  - 3.3 Any clothing, accessories, or body art that have words, terms, or pictures that may be offensive to other employees is unacceptable (or must be concealed).
  - 3.4 Certain footwear is not appropriate for all workplaces (flip-flops, open-toe, open-heel, etc.) Refer to site specific policy if available.
  - 3.5 The policy above applies to all employees represented by the OCU unless there are Facility/Plant specific guidelines in place. Manager or Line HR representative should connect with the employee to communicate the details of the Facility/Plant specific guidelines.
  - 3.6 Employees who travel for company business are expected to represent the company in a professional manner and dress appropriately.
